Dr. Reiff finished teaching the Physics of Ham Radio class in December. Two Rice students and four "visiting teachers" took the class for graduate credit, three other teachers participated for Professional Development hours, and five others audited the class. All learned about waves, electronics, antennas, the ionosphere, the magnetosphere, and space weather. The tuitions for all except the Rice students were supported this grant. Nine were able get a new or upgraded ham radio license, and two with existing licenses learned a lot more about the subjects.
